A Holistic Approach to Education for Grades K through 12

At Martin Luther School, the student is at the center of learning. Across our curriculum, students engage in challenging activities designed to draw from their interests and create opportunities to discover new passions and talents. We develop four crucial skills: collaboration, communication, creativity, and critical thinking. These skills are vital for students to become life-long learners in our rapidly changing world.



SOCIAL STUDIES

Our curriculum follows broad themes including geography, economics, government, and historical analysis skills with an emphasis on providing multiple perspectives.





MUSIC

Our exploratory music program provides a full musical landscape and exposes children to various genres and instruments.



ART

Our multimedia arts program helps students develop artistic skills by cultivating creative expression and an understanding of textures, shapes, and colors.



ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS

Our core belief is that learning deepens when students think, talk, read, and write about authentic texts across many different instructional contexts. Our curriculum is supported by the science of reading, with a variety of strategies to support emerging readers.



PE & HEALTH

The health and physical education curriculum follows the American Standards for Health Safety and Physical Education. The curriculum provides the student with the knowledge base and skills that enable them to achieve and maintain a physically active and healthy life.



MATH

Our program, aligned to the PA Core Standards, emphasizes procedural skills and conceptual understanding to ensure students are learning and applying the critical information to succeed at higher levels.



LIBRARY

Our Media Specialist manages and sources current books and best practices within this realm. All classes have equal access to both regularly scheduled library time as well as research opportunities.



SCIENCE

Science lessons follow the NextGen standards for scientific inquiry and understanding. We encourage students to think like scientists.



TECHNOLOGY

Students use technology as a regular part of daily instruction. We offer technology platforms created to support and extend our students' academic work.

A RESTORATIVE PRACTICE APPROACH

Martin Luther School is a Restorative Practices school. This approach to student behavior promotes healthy relationships and positive discipline inside and outside of school. A restorative approach to conflict focuses on solving problems and repairing harm. Our goal is to have our students and staff use this tool throughout their lives, beyond Martin Luther School.

SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL LEARNING PHILOSOPHY

Our faculty and staff are trained in Social and Emotional Learning (SEL), a process in which people understand and manage emotions, set and achieve goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions. Designed to increase students' emotional skills and literacy, and foster self-regulation by providing tools to assist them, the Martin Luther School SEL program uses various approaches. Our program also teaches students how to recognize a broader range of emotions, gain perspective into how others see and react to their behavior, increase insight, and determine when and how to use strategies like problem-solving to cultivate a more caring and self-aware learning environment.

SPECIALIZED SERVICES:

Speech-Language therapy

Our speech pathology program identifies, evaluates, and provides interventions for a wide variety of communication disorders students may experience. Speech-language programs are developed individually to help each student reach their academic and social goals.



Occupational therapy

Students who experience fine motor, coordination, and sensory regulation needs that impede their learning are paired with occupational therapists to evaluate, identify, and support the use of assistive technology to help students engage in their learning.

Physical therapy

Students who present with gross motor and coordination needs are provided with physical therapy with a referral and clearance from the student's physician. Our team of dedicated physical therapists partner with teachers and students to help students progress to independence and successfully participate in their learning.
