The LaunchPAD Program offers the **Family Check-Up Online**, a helpful web-based tool for families with children ages 2–8. It provides information about early childhood development and caregiver

mental health along with coaching on positive parenting practices. Families take part in parent training courses that encourage healthy, safe, and nurturing environments where children can thrive and grow.

- Parents receive personalized feedback and support to help them address family challenges in a proactive and positive way

Why Choose Family Check-Up Online?

The Family Check-Up Online has been shown to have many benefits in childhood, adolescence, and young adulthood that are long-lasting and lead to the following:

- Reduced substance use
- Reduced likelihood of arrest in early adulthood

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Who is eligible to participate in the Family Check-Up Online?

This web-based tool is designed for families with children between the ages of 2 and 8 years old. It is especially helpful for families experiencing challenges with child behavior, emotional regulation, or parenting stress.

Is there a cost to participate in Family Check-Up Online?

No. This is offered at no cost to participants.

How long does the program take?

The Family Check-Up Online is a flexible and brief intervention. Families typically complete the initial assessment and goal-setting process within a few sessions, followed by ongoing support with LaunchPAD's Community Partners.

How can I access Family Check-Up Online?
